Cans, Plastic, Bottles, Containers & Jugs Go in the Bin

- Plastic bottles, jugs & containers (Bottles must be rinsed, containers including dairy and frozen dishes must be washed)
- Plastic bags (grocery & shopping)
- Bi-Metal (canned foods) & Aluminum beverage cans
- Plastic hangars



Paper Recycling includes:

- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Circulars
- Catalogs
- Office paper
- Sticky notes
- Notebook paper
- Cereal, and similar cardboard boxes
- Stationery
- Corrugated cardboard boxes (flattened)
- Envelopes
- Telephone books
- Junk mail

*** If your paper products are in large volume, place them in a paper bag and set it next to your bin.**

Keep These Tips In Mind When Recycling...

- Place your recycling at the curb by 7AM on your designated recycling day.
- Poly-Styrofoam products (to-go containers, etc) and paper milk cartons are NOT recyclable.
- Return metal hangars to dry cleaners.
- On windy days, secure recycling materials by placing full sacks of paper on top of bin.
- If you need a second recycling bin, call Republic Waste Services 281 446-2030; there is no charge for additional bins.
- Glass and any other recyclable items can be taken directly to Vista Fibers, 1200 Brittmoore Road, Houston, Texas 77043. Open 24/7. Phone 713-461-9933
